Throughout 2024, we will be coordinating workshops to help families apply for Temporary Protected Status.

Temporary Protected Status (TPS) Benefits:

- TPS **IS** permission to stay in the U.S. and authorization to work.
- TPS is **NOT** a permanent legal status in the U.S. It is valid for only 18 months.
- TPS **MIGHT** be extended at the end of the 18-month period, depending on the conditions in your country.
- TPS is **NOT** a path to a green card or U.S. citizenship.

Qualifying Criteria for TPS Applicants (see page 2 for Eligibility Chart):

- Citizen of a TPS-Eligible **Country**.
- Arrived in the U.S. on or before **U.S. Arrival Date**.
- Arrived in the U.S. before **Continuous Physical Presence in the U.S. Since** date.

Evidence Required for Initial TPS Application:

- Identity and Nationality Evidence (national ID, birth certificate, or passport).
- Date of Entry Evidence (I-94, Notice to Appear, any document that shows your first interaction with U.S. immigration authorities)
- Continuous Residence (CR) Evidence (rental housing contract, utility bill, phone bill, anything that shows that you have been living in the U.S. since you entered)

Additional Evidence for Asylum Seekers or Anyone with an Immigration Court Case

- Notice to Appear with Immigration Court
- Copy of your asylum application, if already submitted to immigration
